

Documentation for preselection, Master in Visual Arts

Your file includes 4 items bundled in one pdf file of max 50 MB. Content and technical requirements are in place. Please take this into account.

Content

1. **CV**
2. **Personal motivation** (max 500 words)
3. **Proposal for master project**

You explain the research and possible outcome of your master's project. In other words: What will be the content of your artistic work, and how do you intend to achieve this? This proposal should obviously in no way restrict you in your artistic process, and may and probably will change in the course of your process. Your proposal should be about 1 A4, possibly supplemented with visual elements, explaining your starting point.

Specific to Fashion

The master project proposal should include a collection of 12 silhouettes focusing on research, sketches, material.

4. Digital portfolio

- Your portfolio includes an overview of your artistic work (sketchbooks, illustrations, drawings, photos...), and reflects how your artistic abilities and ideas have evolved over the last few years.
- Your portfolio highlights your research and working methods. After all, the way you developed your work is as important as the result.
- You mention useful info such as the date of a work, materials used, exhibitions, locations, etc.
- You describe your role in the process for work created together with others.

Specific for Fashion

- Your artistic baggage should be visible in your portfolio.
- You provide a full picture of the collection(s) from your previous courses, with all related aspects such as coupe, choice of materials, choice of colours, research.
- You provide a range of silhouettes and materials, and you add the drawings of these silhouettes as well.



Technical requirements

- All content must be present in **one PDF document**. Which means, no references to an online storage service such as - for example - WeTransfer, DropBox, Google Drive, ... nor to a personal website.
- Maximum file size of the PDF document is **50 MB**. You can reduce your portfolio via www.smallpdf.com.
- You may **upload only once!** Additional submissions will be deleted.

If your submission does not meet the requirements, your application will not be valid.
